
M.V. "DUNAFRIC"

The case of this vessel, in which a 2nd S.S.No.2, due 4,35 after a late S.S.No.3, has been partly held, is fully stated in endorsement dated 30.4.36.

The vessel has been laid up in the Tyne, for sale, and a letter has now been received from the Newcastle Surveyors stating they are informed that the vessel has been sold to Messrs. T.W.Ward Ltd. for demolition, and that she will probably be towed away from the Tyne to Rosyth today. (8th und)

It is submitted the record of "To be broken up" be posted against this vessel's name in the Register Book.
