Dear Sirs,


I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of to-day's date respecting the motorship "DUNAFRIC", the purchase of which has to-day been concluded by the White Shipping Co., Ltd., Newcastle, and note that the new Owners are negotiating her sale for demolition to North Spain.

The Committee have had the case under consideration to-day, and I am directed to say that they will be prepared to authorise the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle to issue an interim certificate to enable the vessel to retain her class for the contemplated voyage to North Spain, provided an opportunity is afforded the Surveyors of visiting the vessel with a view to their ascertaining that she is in a satisfactory condition to make the voyage in question.
