Survey held, &c.

A 2nd S.S.No.2, due 4,35 after a late S.S.No.3, has been partly held and the greater part of the survey remains to be carried out.

The shell plating requires to be drilled at this survey, the vessel being now more than 24 years old.

A proposal to complete the survey within the year of grace has been agreed to.

In reply to enquiry the Owners state that the vessel is at present laid up at Dunkirk and that they have not yet decided definitely as to her employment or when the Special Survey will be completed.

The year of grace expired 4,36.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Owners asked to furnish the usual undertaking.

PLATING to be DRILLED when vessel is 24 years old, at this Special Survey thereafter.
