



Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith verification form of freeboard of the steamer "DUNAFRIC" and have to report that (1) Satisfactory means have now been provided for closing openings of air pipes and (2) Lifelines have been provided in forward and after wells for protection of crew.

With regard to machinery casings in Superstructure deck there are only 4 Skylights having steel coamings 7/16" thickness, over Engines Room. These are all fitted with watertight covers. (2 Skylights have coamings 27" in height and 2 have coamings 22" - 13 1/2" in height.
