I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant from which I am pleased to note that you desire to submit the motorships "LANDVARD", "LIDVARD" and "FOLKVARD", which have now become your property, to the inspection of the Society's Surveyors with a view to Reclassification, and I have to say that provided the requirements of the Rules for the Special Survey N°3, on the hull and machinery, be complied with and the vessels be favourably reported upon, the original class 100 All Awaiting Deck with Freeboard will be reinstated in the Register Book.

I note that the "LIDVARD" will be submitted to survey at Rotterdam at this time, and I am accordingly forwarding the necessary instructions to the Society's Surveyors. Perhaps you will be so good as to let me know in due course at what ports the "LANDVARD" and "FOLKVARD" will be submitted for survey in order that
