Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of Mr. Lystad's letter of the 17th instant respecting the S.S. "LIDVARD", and in reply thereto I have to state that the freeboard assigned and originally reported to be correctly marked is required to be measured from the top of the statutory deck line $1\frac{3}{4}$ " above the iron deck at side, and it was reported that the awning deck was not wood sheathed at middle of length.

The certificates are sent herewith for issue provided marking is made in accordance with the assignment as originally reported and not from the wood awning deck as now reported.

I shall be obliged if you will be good enough to advise me upon the matter in due course.
