Dear Sir,

We are forwarding herewith enclosed Verification Form Report C.12 (c) for the Convention Freeboards assigned to the above vessel.

The conditions of assignment, as set forth in your assigning letter M. dated 27/7/32 addressed to the Naples Surveyor, have been complied with as under:-

- 1) An efficient steel cover fitted to the forward cargo hatchway on the freeboard deck.
- 2) All air pipes have been protected with wire gauze at openings.
- 3) Half the length of the bulwarks in the wells have been cut away and replaced by open rails.
- 4) The small hatchway on the freeboard deck in the forecastle space has been provided with efficient wood covers.
- 5) The coaling hatchways on the freeboard deck in the poop space have each been provided with one tarpaulin and efficient battening arrangements.

As desired by Mr. V. D. Tompkins, the Owners' Superintendent at Istanbul, the new certificate, together

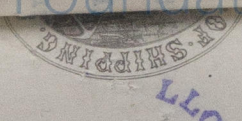
