With reference to the enclosed letter addressed to Mr. James Miller relative to the assignment of Convention freeboards to the steamer "WANDSWORTH WORKS", I beg to acquaint you that it is understood from the Society's Surveyor at Lishon that it has been decided to give the new freeboards marked on the ship's sides and the necessary alterations effected at Alexandria. In the circumstances I shall be glad if Mr. Miller will be guided accordingly and give the case the necessary attention, and you will be so good as to arrange for the usual verification of Working form C/12(c) to be forwarded to this Office in due course together with particulars of the alterations carried out to this ship.

I may add that all fees and expenses incurred in connexion with this inspection must be paid by the Owners or their Representatives, and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
