NOTE. In addresses consisting of a name prefixed to a REGISTERED or ABBREVIATED ADDRESS, or where a telegram is addressed to one person at the house of another whose name is also given, the word "CARE" (at) or some equivalent expression must be inserted after the name of the addressee.

Time is saved and greater accuracy is secured by the Public handing in their telegrams direct to the Company's Stations as above, where receipts are given gratis for the amount charged.

Telegrams for this Company's system are also received at all Postal Telegraph Offices, but should be marked

"VIA EASTERN" or "VIA IMPERIAL" if intended for transmission by cable, or

"VIA MARCONI" or "VIA EMPIRADIO" if intended for transmission by wireless. This indication is not charged for.

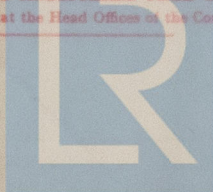
