Dear Sirs,

MM I duly received Mr. Palmer's letter of the 19th instant respecting the Steamer "KALUA", and in reply thereto I am directed to state that as this vessel has never been classed with this Society there are no plans or particulars in this Office other than those in the Register Book.

It will therefore be necessary, in the first place, for plans to be forwarded showing the scantlings and arrangements of hull, machinery and boilers, together with particulars of engines, in order that it may be seen for what class the vessel might be considered eligible.

If there are no plans in the possession of the Owners, it might be possible for them to obtain copies of the original plans from the Builders, Messrs. John Crown & Sons, Ltd., of Sunderland. Otherwise it will be necessary for full particulars to be reported on First Entry Report Forms for the consideration of the Committee; also the requirements of the Rules for vessels not built under survey will require to be complied with.
