VESSEL'S NAME "JESSIE MAERSK" REPORT Hpl. No. 18336

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

"The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class was subject to permanent repairs to shell plating etc. (s.s.amids.) and port and starboard quarters of the Poop at the Owners' convenience and to (a bower anchor and 15 fathoms of chain cable being supplied).

The West Hartlepool Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and extensive damage repairs effected on account of stranding and collision.

2 bower anchors and 120 fathoms of chain cable supplied.
(Bower anchor and 30 fathoms of chain cable to supply)

Shell plating, as above, now dealt with.

The 2nd S.S.No.2, due 5.41 held with the exception of the examination and repairs to the deck forward and aft of the Bridge Ends, examination of the Bridge space and all hatchways including bunker hatches and the scaling and examination of upper parts of holds, examination of masts in way of wedges and of the hand pump (if any).

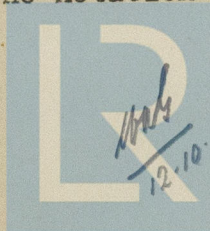
Minor wear and tear repairs effected.

Nothing is stated as to when the S.S. will be completed but in the opinion of the Surveyors, the remaining items, as above, are efficient for 12 moths. Under the circumstances it is submitted a notation of "General Examination" be assigned.

It is therefore submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed with record of Docking Date (9.42) subject to a bower anchor and 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the end of the present emergency and to have the notation "Examined 9.42" valid for 12 months assigned.
