I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant respecting the steamer "KASTELHOLM" and have noted the information contained therein regarding the present movements of this vessel.

I may say that the Boiler Survey was not completed at Liverpool in July last, the Surveyors stating at the time that no arrangements could be made in the matter.

As this inspection was partly held in May last in Buenos Aires and the vessel, according to your information, is now proceeding to that port, I have thought it advisable to cable instructions to the Surveyors there requesting them to endeavour to complete the Boiler Survey while the vessel is at their port.
