Dear Sir,

I am enclosing herewith for the consideration of the Committee, detailed plan of the new furnaces proposed to be fitted by Messrs Brigham & Cowan to the boiler of the ex German vessel s/s "Haines", & should be obliged for their approval or otherwise.

I was not prepared to allow them to carry on with the work, owing to the fact that they were proposing to fit a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " saddle plate, whereas the tube plate is  $\frac{7}{8}$ " thick. The thickness of the furnaces removed is  $\frac{3}{4}$ ". These saddle plates are being fitted in order to make the furnaces withdrawable.

As the repairs are anxious to put the work in hand, would you please wire
