

Steel Screw Ex-German Steamer "NAIMES", No. 66729 in R.B.,
built at Vegesack in 1907, 5332 tons gross, never classed
with this Society.

It is submitted the Newcastle Surveyors should be informed that if the new Owners desire to have this vessel classed with this Society, it will be necessary in the first place for plans of midship section, profile, boilers and pumping arrangements shewing the scantlings and arrangements to be forwarded for comparison with the Society's Rule requirements, in order that it may be seen for what class the vessel is eligible.

If no plans are available, it will be necessary for the Surveyors to obtain particulars of the scantlings by actual measurement at the ship, and forward these on First Entry Report Forms for the consideration of the Committee, and this should be done with the least possible delay.

It will also be necessary for the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules, relating to vessels not built under survey, to be complied with, and for the vessel to be found or placed in good and efficient condition to the Society's satisfaction.
