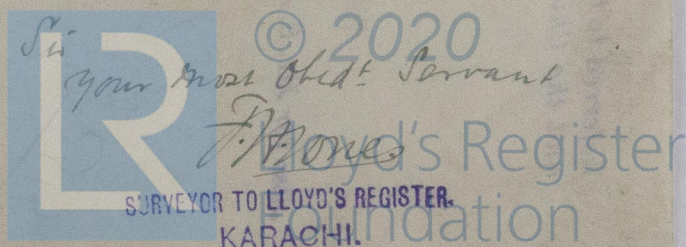
Sir

With reference to your letter "H" dated the 12th Aug^r,
and "M", dated the 26th September 1914, the boiler survey
was carried out at this Port of the "Lord Sefton" on the
26th Sept 1914, particulars are posted this mail.

With reference to the iron propelling dredger, "Graham
Lynn" No 773, this has been completed as far as the
Hull is concerned, the boilers have also been fitted in,
and the pipe connections machinery, and wooden
decks are now being completed, the usual reports for
the Committee's approval will be duly forwarded to
you when the Society's requirements are fulfilled &
the boilers tested under steam press, and safety valves
set. I have sent you a photograph of her after she was
launched, & before the boilers & funnels were fitted
in, she is not expected to be completed for another
month or more.
