Nature of Survey

The class is subject to the vessel being further examined in dry dock and permanent repairs being effected to the stern frame at the Owners' convenience and to the stem shoe, repaired by electric welding 8.31, being specially examined at the next dry docking.


The Rotterdam Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock for examination after grounding. repairs effected to shell plates, beams etc., upper and lower parts of stern frame, rudder head and mainpiece and foundation plate of steering engine all renewed and minor repairs carried out.

A bower anchor and one length of chain cable previously lost have now been recovered and placed on board and this chain cable retested. Two ^{new} lengths of chain cable of proper size, weight and test have also been supplied.

The electric welding repair to the stem has been examined, found satisfactory and the Surveyors recommend the condition regarding same might be removed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 1.32, without special condition, as recommended.
