The undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners, survey the Steel Screw Steamer "ELSA MENZELL" ex "INCHDAIRNIE", for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of the damage stated to have been caused by boilers salting, on a voyage from Antwerp to Savannah.

For further particulars see Log Book and Protest.

On examination of the vessel while lying afloat on the 6th January, 1930, and subsequent dates,

FOUND: Condenser damaged and recommendation made in survey report dated 21st February, 1930, under item 3.

It was understood that the securing of the division plate would be examined by Owners on arrival in Europe and if considered unsatisfactory, that tubes would be drawn, division plate renewed, tubes replaced and repacked, any tubes damaged during the repair, to be renewed.
