I am in receipt of your Supplementary Report No.699 relating to the repairs to the machinery of the above named vessel, which was to-day submitted to the American Committee prior to its transmission to London.

I would point out that no particular mention is made in that Report of the repairs to the astern buckets of the L.P. Turbine, and in view of your letter of the 29th ultimo, the following note has been added at this Office:-

"The astern buckets of L.P.turbine (referred to on previous Report) are now in order."

It is also noted that the last date shown on this Supplementary Report is the 11th January, and it is concluded that this is in error as the record of WIMC 2,30 was assigned on the basis of the dates shown on your previous Report.
