Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th instant, respecting the Glasgow first entry reports Nos. 41621 and 41622 on the Water Tube Boilers Nos. 1107/8 made by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd., for "H" Type Standard vessels, and to say that as the fees chargeable for the survey of boilers during construction for standard vessels are payable by the Builders, accounts should accordingly be rendered to Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox.

In view of the fact that the gross tonnage of "H" Type Standard vessels, for which these boilers were intended, is about 6500, the fee for the survey of the boilers during construction will be £3610:0 for each of the two sets of three boilers.

The above fees have been noted on the reports, and should be passed through the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
