With reference to my letter of the 11th March last, I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know, as this vessel appears to have arrived at Malmo on the 21st ultimo, when and at what port the Owners propose to have the requisite drydocking, under the survey of the Society's and repairs and the completion of the Special Survey No.2 carried out.

I may say that the Jacksonville Surveyor has now reported that all the machinery repairs were satisfactorily completed whilst the vessel was under his survey and she has accordingly been assigned the record SLMC 2,30 without condition.

The vessel arrived at Kiel yesterday and is now lying at the yard of Messrs. Deutsche Werke, Kiel, for the purpose of carrying out repairs and completing the Special Survey No. 2. The vessel is expected to come under the survey of the Society's Surveyors in the course of the next few days.
