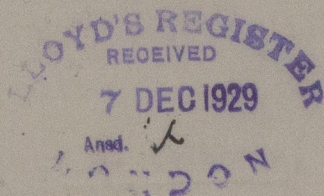

Dear Sir,

On communicating the contents of your letter of the 3rd instant to the Owners of the s.s. "INCHDAIRNIE" the Owners requested that in order to avoid any possible delay in the expedition of the ship from Savannah to Germany a cablegram might be sent to you requesting you to inform the Jacksonville Surveyor by cablegram as regards the decision arrived at by the Committee in regard to the postponement of the completion of the Special Survey No 2. I accordingly cabled you today as follows:-
