No. 2 SURVEY PARTLY HELD.

When proposed to be completed

The S.S. No.2, due 5,29, was partly held at Rotterdam in January last by the examination of the bottom and rudder in dry dock, opening of all double bottom tanks and fore and after peak tanks and examination of the windlass.

The Antwerp Surveyors reported in March last that the steering gear cylinders had been renewed and the telemotor gear overhauled.

In April the vessel lost her rudder and sustained damage at sea.

The new Owners now state that the vessel is under repair at Antwerp and request to be informed of what part of the survey has been carried out.

It is submitted the Owners and Jacksonville Surveyor be informed as above.
