
The Special Survey No.2 due 5,29 has been partly held, and the vessel also retained her class subject to the suction valve chests of the main ^{FEED} steam pump being renewed, safety valves of the centre main boiler being adjusted under steam, and repairs being effected to the boilers as recommended by the Surveyors at Jacksonville in July 1929.

The vessel is at present at Jacksonville, held up there by defective boilers.

Messrs, Menzell Reederei A.G. state they have purchased this ship and that as the repair of the vessel at Savannah is now proceeding they will be obliged if instructions are sent to the Surveyor at Jacksonville by cablegram to attend again if invited to do so by the Master or their Agent.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Surveyor at Jacksonville be instructed accordingly.
