With reference to your First Entry Report No.15992, on the machinery of the S.S. "KINGHORN", I have to inform you that an account has to-day been rendered to the Director of Transports and Shipping for the fees due for the survey of the engines and boilers during construction, and the installation on board.

Of the total amount, the proportion due to your port for the fitting on board of the machinery is £36. 2. 10, and on payment, your account will be credited accordingly which you will be good enough to note and see that the necessary entries are passed through your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
