Dear Sir,

Reverting to my letter of the 13th instant respecting the steamer "ELSA MENZELL", I have to acquaint you I am now in receipt of the New York Surveyors' report from which it appears that the overboard discharge pipe from the condenser has been renewed as recommended by the Boston Surveyor, and the Surveyors recommend that the copper exhaust pipe between the H.P. and L.P. astern turbine should be renewed on the vessel's arrival at Hamburg, as previously intimated.

The New York Surveyors also recommend that the vessel should be further examined at a home port on account of ice damage, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will arrange for the case to receive the necessary attention in due course.
