Action was deferred for permanent repairs to the steering engine

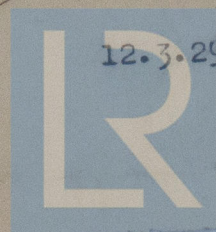
The Antwerp Surveyors now report that the steering engine cylinders have been renewed and the telemotor gear overhauled.
