I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam report that the cylinders of the steering engine of the steamer "INCHDAIRNIE" are defective, and that the same will be made good at Antwerp, whither the vessel is to be towed.

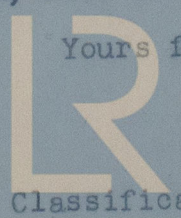
In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will satisfy yourselves regarding the repairs carried out at your port, and that the steering gear is in an efficient condition before the vessel proceeds to sea.

I may add that the Special Survey No.2 which becomes due in May next has been partly held at Rotterdam by the examination of the bottom and rudder in drydock, the testing of all the double bottom tanks and the fore and after peak tanks, and the examination of the windlass. To complete the survey of the machinery for the record LMC 2,29, the suction valve chest of the main feed pumps requires to be renewed, and it is stated this will also be done at Antwerp.
