Sent in reply to wire received yesterday as follows.

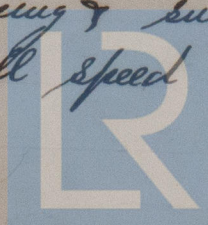
Received.

HP turbine thrust. Owner proposes to fit old turbine
for one Atlantic Voyage without renewing rotor
shaft. Give case immediate attention and inform
this office whether in your opinion owners
proposal is satisfactory

Inchdairnie. Owner's proposal refit old turbine
for one voyage can be approved provided
satisfactory on full speed trial. Surveyors.

It is now proposed to turn up old turbine
thrust collars, remetal its bearings, & fit old
turbine rotor in new casing & subject the
machinery to 6 hours full speed trial before
vessel sails.
