Surveyed the steel screw steamer "KINGHORN" of Bergen, 6504 Tons Gross Register, while lying afloat at the Delaware River Steel Company's Wharf, Chester, Pa.

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that she be continued as classed SPECIAL Shelter Deck with freeboard, without fresh record of survey, subject to the Deep Tank not being used for water ballast until repairs to top of same are effected. The Vessel now being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.
