I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th instant relative to the steamer "KINGHORN", and in reply to your enquiry I have to say that to complete the Special Survey No.1 of this vessel the port pocket bunker and the engine and boiler spaces require to be examined, all the double bottom tanks (including No.4 dry tank under the boilers) to be examined internally, the peak tanks, deep tank and the No.5 D.B. tank tested and the pumps and watertight doors examined. The vessel will be eligible for the record \* LMC 7,24 when the thrust shaft has been surveyed.


