
I am now however informed by those gentlemen that they found the vessel had commenced loading grain immediately upon her arrival and they were unable to arrange for the loading to be stopped to afford them an opportunity of making the desired examination.

The Owners' Agents and the Ship's Officers were informed of the state of affairs, but they stated the vessel was about to sail for Naples and that the attention of the Surveyors at that port would be called to the survey which is required.

I may add that copies of the correspondence have been forwarded to the Naples Surveyors for their information.
