We are today in receipt of a letter from Messrs. Società Italiana Ernesto Breda, Mestre, stating that the demolition of this vessel has been commenced in February last.

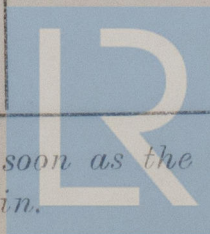

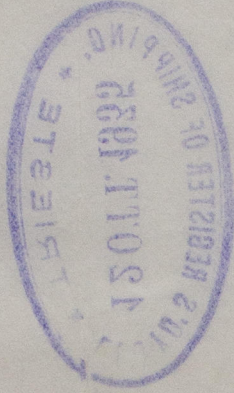
