With reference to the Secretary's letter of the 6th June "M" regarding the S/S "BENEFACITOR", I beg to inform you that the alterations required to conform to the International Load Line Convention as contained in the Secretary's letter have now been carried out as follows:-

- (1) The stokehold grating covers, fiddley ventilators and engine room skylight have now been made efficient.
- (2) All the air pipes have now been provided with wood plugs.
- (3) Efficient lifelines and supports have now been provided for the protection of the crew in both the fore and after wells.
- (4) The hatch covers to the six coaling hatches on the freeboard deck have now been made efficient.
- (5) The coamings, hatch beams, covers, tarpaulins and battening arrangements to the six coal hatches on the freeboard deck are now to the convention requirements.
