With reference to the Steel Screw Steamer 410 ft.
proposed to be built by Messrs. D. & W. Henderson & Co.,
enclose herewith the usual letter giving particulars
of the freeboards which have been provisionally assigned
to this vessel, subject to the deck erections being closed
required for full allowance.

I have to point out that the freeboard has been
calculated with a tonnage co-efficient of .75 and is subject
to modification if necessary on completion.

In view of the rising tank at margin I shall be glad
to be informed on completion whether the tonnage is Suez
tonnage.

I also send herewith an outline plan giving particulars
of freeboard computation, and shall be glad if you will be
good enough to return the same with the final report.
