Following satisfactory Modified Special Surveys which were carried out, the Committee agreed to extend this vessel's class until the end of this month.

The Owners now state that the vessel is due at Osaka between the 15th and 29th of this month when she will be handed over for breaking up.

It is submitted that when the vessel arrives at Osaka the record of "To be broken up" be posted against her name in the Register Book.
