Sir. We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your favour of the 25<sup>th</sup> instant & enclosure, regarding the case of the S/S Hera's Stern frame, which was temporarily repaired in July 1912 with the view to its renewal in about three months time, vide GR Rep 16285

We have to inform you that in our opinion the repairs might be considered permanent, and the class continued without special conditions, subject to the stern post being examined whilst the vessel is in dry dock and found satisfactory. The rudder should be lifted, and the gudgeons examined particularly the upper gudgeon which was reported strained.
