Gentlemen,

I have to acquaint you that the steamer "HERA" was classed by the Glasgow Committee in July last subject to her stern frame, which was damaged when the steamer was launched and temporarily repaired at that time, being renewed within three months. In the following October the Owners requested that as they had not an opportunity of stopping the vessel and dry docking her, that the certificate might be extended until the end of the ~~last~~ <sup>last</sup> month, which arrangements was agreed to by the Committee.

It is observed that the vessel arrived at Hamburg on the 24th ultimo and I shall therefore be glad to learn what arrangements the Owners propose to make regarding the matter in question.

I should add that the damage to the stern frame consisted of the fracture ~~of~~ one of the gudgeons which was cut off and temporarily replaced by a riveted gudgeon.
