Dear Sir,

Oil Tank Steamer "HERA".

We enclose herewith a letter dated the 14th instant received from Messrs. Palmers Hebburn Co. Ltd. enquiring as to the reduction, if any, which could be allowed in the existing freeboard of this vessel, taking also into account a proposal to introduce an additional tank 22'-6" long which would thus increase the length B.P.

The vessel holds a notation of S.S. Nwc. 2-29 in the Society's Register Book, and according to Lloyd's List has been laid up at Dartmouth since 1st September 1930.

As the vessel is now almost 25 years of age and has been laid up for $6\frac{1}{2}$ years, it is submitted for consideration whether, before replying to Messrs. Palmers' enquiry, an examination of the vessel afloat be carried out to ascertain her present condition, and whether there is any material reduction from the original scantlings.

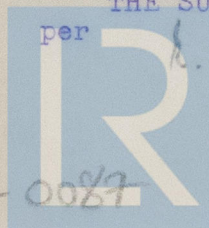
