Sir .

In reply to your letter of the 16th instant having regard to measurements for obtaining the Society's freeboard of the ~~the~~ steamer " H E R A " , I have to report that we have visited the vessel to day , in order to obtain the necessary particulars ; but we received the information from the Owners Office at this Port , that we were not allowed to take any particulars on board of the vessel , as long as they had not been instructed from the Hamburg Office.-

I have explained them , that the Owners had sent in an application for freeboard at the London Office , and that it would be in their interest , if they allowed <sup>us</sup> to take the required particulars as far as now practicable , but they refused to do so.-

With a view to this I have now returned the approved plans received with your letter for our guidance , and may state , that the measurement of sheer will not be possible while the vessel is lying at the Petroleum wharf at this Port .

She leaves this Port again to morrow midday.-
