Dear Mr. McNab,

With reference to the case of the Steamer "HERA", Messrs. The Greenock & Grangemouth Dockyard Co's S.S. No. 335 which was measured by the German Authorities for tonnage as per your letter to me of the 29th May last, I shall be much obliged if you can ascertain and let me know whether the under deck tonnage given as 4196 is exclusive of peak tanks, and if so could you get the Builders to kindly oblige by giving the estimated tonnage of these spaces. Also to oblige with the estimated tonnage of the space between the inner bottom in the E&B space and the line of bottom longitudinals continued.

I may say that the Owners have applied to us for a freeboard assignment and we have just had a report in from Rotterdam, and I shall be glad to have the information asked for to enable us to deal with the case.
