Précis of particulars of Casualty

The 3rd Special Survey N. 1 which became due in December, 1935, has been partly held.

The vessel has been laid up & the Owners furnished the usual undertaking

She was recently reported to have been sold to British purchasers for breaking up purposes.

The vessel left Hull on the 21st April for Sunderland in ballast (See Hull letter 23/4/36).

The Sunderland Surveyors state, in letters dated 23rd & 25th April, that the vessel has arrived at their port, & the work of demolition has now been commenced.

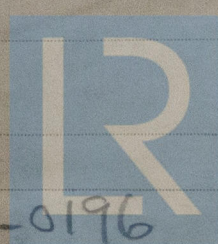
