In reply to your letter of the 15th January last, in reference to my Reports of Survey 1490 and 1496 of surveys held on the "BULGARIAN" at this Port, I have to report that the following vessel examined in February 1934 may in my opinion be classed as part 3rd Special Survey N°1.

- 5. Hull. Examination of the Starboard Engine Room double bottom tank internally and testing of same.
Nos.1, 2, 3 and 4 cargo holds and tween decks down to bilge ceiling boards.
Decks and deck houses, hatchways and coamings, hatch covers, cleats, tarpaulins and battening arrangements, ventilators and coamings.
Testing of Nos.1, 2, Starboard Engine Room Tank and 5 & 6 Double Bottom Tanks as by the Rules.
- 6. Machinery. H. P. connecting rod top end brasses and crosshead pins.
Main engine feed pump rams and suction and delivery valves.
I.P. connecting rod top and bottom end brasses with pins and crank forward.
- 7. Drydocking. To complete examination for 3rd Special Survey N°1 Rudder to be lifted also dented port side shell plates in way of N°1 hold to be dealt with.
