With reference to my letter of the 3rd ultimo respecting the steamer "BULGARIAN", I beg to inform you that I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Hull, stating that they have been informed by your Agents at that port that no arrangements are being made for carrying out the overdue Third Special Survey No.1, and that the vessel will be laid up at that port in the meantime.
