Dear Sirs,

In reply to your letter of today's date respecting the case of the steamer "BULGARIAN", I beg to inform you that the Committee have agreed to the vessel's classification being maintained until the steamer's arrival in Hull from this port where, it is noted, she is to complete discharging her cargo.

I would add that, in the ordinary course, as the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Third Special Survey No.1 expired at the end of last month, this survey will require to be carried out before the vessel again goes into commission, and if she is to remain laid up at Hull, the Committee in such cases require Owners to furnish a letter of undertaking that the Survey will be carried out before the vessel again proceeds to sea, or in the event of her sale intending purchasers will be informed of the conditions under which her class has been allowed to remain undisturbed in the Register Book whilst laid up.
