I beg to acquaint you that Messrs. P. Wigham Richardson & Co., Ltd., have forwarded here a copy of their letter to you of the 9th instant regarding the loss of the steamer "KAFIRISTAN".

With regard thereto I think it well to explain that permission has recently been received from the Admiralty to record in the Society's Register Book such War Losses as have been reported in the Public Press.

It is proposed to record the same by means of a casualty notation of "SUNK - WAR LOSS" but in every case the Owners' consent to this procedure is being obtained.

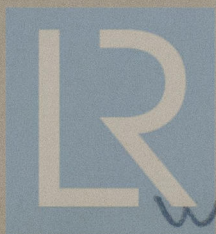
