With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the motorship "SEWINGOLE" I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report from the Society's Surveyors at Belfast of Survey held by them on the vessel in May/June last when a specification of necessary repairs was drawn up.
