upper cargo oil tanks, pump rooms, cofferdams, fore hold, machinery spaces,
and after peak tanks & spaces above, fore deep tank, double bottom tanks in
machinery space.
Heads, decks and shell were drilled where considered necessary & thicknesses
measured, but excepting in way of these drillings no scale was removed.
