The 2nd S.S.No.2 became due 2,34 and the vessel being laid up the usual undertaking was furnished.

The vessel has been sold to Italian Buyers for breaking up purposes.

With a view to the vessel proceeding in ballast to<sup>a</sup> North European Port and thence with a cargo to an Italian Port for demolition (See Secretary's letter 14.3.35) the London Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat and a satisfactory general examination including the windlass, steering gear and pumping arrangements carried out.

A certificate has been issued accordingly.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Genoa Surveyors requested to advise this Office when the work of demolition has been commenced.
