
The 2nd S.S.No.3 became due 4,31 and no part of the survey has been held.

The vessel has been laid up at Dordrecht since early in 1931 and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

The vessel was last inspected by the Society's Surveyors in July 1933, when a general examination afloat was held.

The Owners now state that the vessel has been sold to Messrs. Metal Industries Ltd. for breaking up in the Forth. They state that the vessel will pass out of their possession on 11th/13th instant, and that the buyers intend to tow the ship away.

It is submitted the vessel might be posted as "To be broken up" in the Register Book.

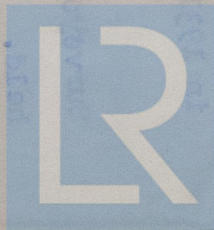
