
Dear Sir,

s.s "PURLEY OAKS": Thank you for your letter "H" of yesterday, and we would like to refer you to our letter of 10th October last stating that this vessel is still laid up at Dordrecht, but that we had practically sold her for breaking. The sale we then had in view fell through, and the vessel has remained, and still remains, at Dordrecht laid up. Yesterday afternoon, however, we signed a contract with Metal Industries Ltd. for the sale of the vessel for demolition in the Forth, and have this morning received the deposit money due to us in connection with the sale.

You may take it therefore that the vessel will pass out of our possession on 11th/13th inst. and we understand that it is the intention of the buyers to tow the vessel away from Dordrecht to the Forth for demolition.
